

# Hayden Run

The Hayden Run planning area of Franklin County is bound by the county border to the north and west, Scioto River to the east, and Hayden Run and Davidson Roads to the south. The area is home to 47,200 people with an estimated 8.3% being children under the age of six. Of these, 3% are living in households below 125% of the Federal Poverty Level. This is the lowest proportion in Franklin County, and well below the county average of 30%. Additionally, 92% of children are estimated to be in married couple families—well above the countywide estimate of 64%.

The availability of proximal and affordable child care is critical to the local economy as it enables parents and caregivers to work or further their education. After adjusting for parental labor force status, the Hayden Run and Near East areas are the only two planning areas of the 27 to have a demand to supply ratio of 1 to 1 for children under age six.

The average weekly costs of center-based child care in Hayden Run are some of the highest in Franklin County. There are 22 child care centers and 9 are accredited or quality rated, resulting in a ratio of 2.7 to 1 for this type of care for children under age six—the second lowest in Franklin County.

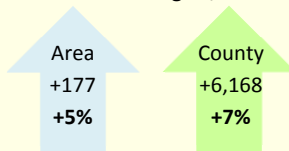

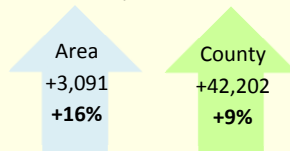

### Households, 2010-2020

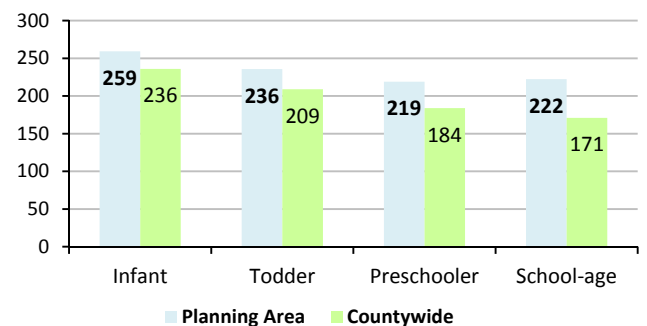

- American Community Survey, 2005-2009 – income and parental labor force adjustment factor (children assumed in need of care only if all present parents in labor force)
- MORPC – household projections, 2010-2035 (extrapolated for 2020 by CRP)
- Ohio Department of Education – active public and private elementary schools (2012)
