standards require that any community based or school program participating in SUTQ you must have and be implementing a fully aligned curriculum. The curriculum you chose needs to be aligned to the Early Learning and Development Standards (ELDS) and to the Science of Reading (SOR).

Research different developmentally-appropriate curricula that would best fit your programs educational philosophy. Different curricula emphasize different skills, teaching methods and content depth, while some focus on rote memorization while others prioritize inquiry-based or hands-on learning.
